Tournament information:

- 1. Teams are guaranteed 3 games (NOT Double Elimination). Co-Ed teams accepted in the boy's brackets.
- 2. Both divisions will play on 10 ft. goals. Sr. boys will play with boy's ball; all others will play with girl's ball.
- 3. Entry fees are \$100 per team.
- 4. The tournament will be limited to 32 teams. 8 Teams per division/gender. First-come, first-served basis.

- 9. A full concession serving breakfast, lunch and dinner items will be available during the tournament, so we would appreciate teams refraining from bringing outside food into the gyms.

Melrose Mini Pak Tournament Rules

Generally high school rules with the following exceptions:

Tournament officials have the right to make any changes or decisions deemed necessary.

Home Team= Top of bracket—will sit to scorekeepers right.

All Divisions:

- 3-point shot counts
- Full Court Press allowed.
- Time outs 3 full per game (1 min each)
- 5 minute half-time (unless schedule necessitates changes at the discretion of tournament officials)
- 10 minutes between games (unless schedule necessitates changes at the discretion of tournament officials)
- 2 minute overtime running clock Second overtime will be sudden death
- Only 2 adult coaches/book keepers allowed on the bench
- No youths on the bench other than those on official roster
- Only head coach is allowed off the bench during the game
- Foul language from players or coach will not be tolerated (Automatic ejection may be exercised on 1st offense.)
- 3 games guaranteed this is NOT a double elimination tournament

3rd – 4th Grade BOYS/GIRLS

- 15 minute running halves, Running clock (clock stops for time outs only & last 2 minutes of game)
- 28.5 girls ball
- Free shots from the white line
- With 10 point lead, press must drop back to 10 ft. volleyball line

5th -6th Grade BOYS/GIRLS

- 20 minute running halves, Running clock (clock stops for time outs only & last 2 minutes of game)
- 28.5 girls ball 29.5 boys ball
- · Free shots from free shot line
- · With 20 point lead defense drops back to 10 ft. volleyball line
