Melrose Elementary School offers a Preschool environment for qualifying children. The Kindergarten offering is a full-day program, which meets five days a week. Both programs are set to prepare children for the First Grade through Sixth Grade "learning experience" including social, intellectual, and academic challenges and performance. All grades are offered in individual classrooms. The curriculum includes all state requirements including the fine arts. Accelerated Reading and Accelerated Math are additional programs utilized in the school. The Fourth Grade, Fifth Grade, and Sixth Grade are included in the Enrichment Program; students participate in Drama, Art, Spanish, and "Kids with Character." These grades also change classes and utilize program departmentalization. The Melrose Elementary School encompasses a computer lab and library with Book Fairs being established regularly. A certified science instructor presents science classes.



Six bus routes are operated on a daily basis. The board, administration, teaching staff, and support personnel are united in their dedication to provide education of the highest quality.
